ERB members stated that they will urge the Village Board to review its policy on sidewalks to promote pedestrian usage.

Mastrantoni – Tax Map Designation 111-15-13 - 18 New Street. Building renovation to open barber shop/beauty salon

The project includes a renovation of the 1000 sq. ft. building, installation of a fence, landscaping and the paving of the existing parking lot.

The ERB made the following observations and recommendations:

- A detailed site plan with elevations is needed to fully review the site.
- The Rio Grande, one of the most impacted streams in Orange County, runs behind the building and should be protected from runoff.
- Recommends pervious pavement and a berm to direct the runoff.
- Recommends the planting of additional trees if space allows.

Environmental Projects

ERB members Jason Wilson and Debra Marone did a walk of the Rio Grande a few weeks ago and will share information with other ERB members at a future meeting. Mr. Wilson said he is looking forward to the ERB making positive changes to the environment in the Village.
