
Illuminate Goshen: Greg inquired about whether Illuminate Goshen was incorporating solar to power those lights. Jason will follow-up to find out. Sally inquired as to whether the lights are easy to disco in event of emergency vehicles.

Solarize Goshen: Final info session today. Opportunities to share info might be Solar Open House 8/22, Goshen Family Fun Day 8/22, Goshen Strong 8/29 12-6, and Goshen Art Walk 9/4. Possible opportunities might be a website to show status of signees. Sally is trying to get the fire commissioners information about solar/fire training opportunities.

Tree City, USA/Trees for Tribs: Jason mentioned following up on finding about the funding cycle for tribs. <http://www.arboday.org/programs/treecityusa/standards.cfm> requires funding of \$2/per capita and forestry council and arbor day event. Maybe there's a way to align the trees for tribs planting event with the arbor day event and using the grant of trees for the per capita requirement. Possible locations to add trees would be surrounding the reservoir and the rio downtown near the DPW.

Water stations: Sally inquired about if water stations have ever been considered to encourage walking and reducing waste as well as encouraging water consumption for overall health. Possible locations might be near the heritage trail and in the parks.
